Police:

4/5 people from the area have been in court recently linked to a number of crimes in the Cheshire area. It is hoped that this will reduce the amount of crime in the area.

There latest crime figures show a reduction in overall crime across Halewood and in particular the West Ward.

Speeding operations have been taking place in Halewood. 2 have been carried out on Torrington Drive, with no speeding vehicles found. It was suggested that future operation on the estate are carried out at weekends.

PACT Meetings – these meeting will soon be replaced by a new initiative – Have your say! T is hoped that this will result in building closer relationships with local community associations.

Bogus caller – a new DVD has been launch to help tackle bogus callers, the DVD is aimed at informing vulnerable residents signs to look out for these unwanted caller and what they can do to protect themselves.
